

Monthly Bulletin of National Tuberculosis Programme

Shrawan, 2081

Highlights

- A total **3314** Drug-Susceptible (DS) TB cases were reported in Shrawan 2081
- A total of 30 Drug-Resistant (DR) TB cases were reported in Shrawan 2081
- Madhesh Province reported the **highest** number of TB cases in this month
- Total number of deaths were **93**
- Out of 3772 registered cases, **209 (6.3%)** were smokers
- HIV status was known in **2920 (88.1%)** of registered TB cases
- DST status was known for **1440 (73.3%)** out of **1909** bacteriologically confirmed pulmonary TB cases.

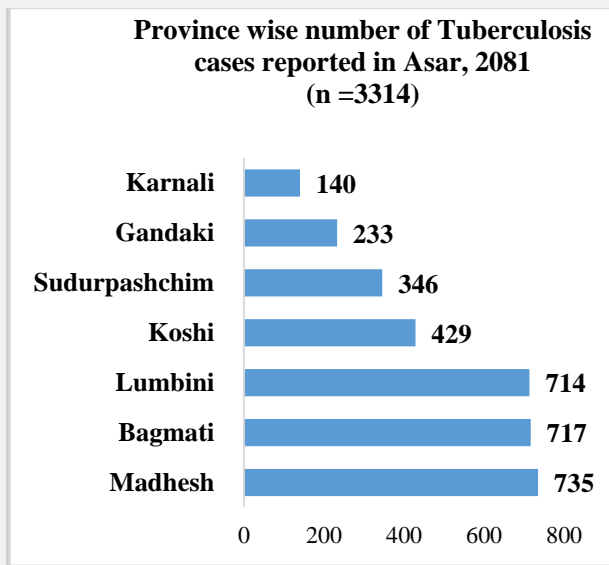


Fig: 1: Province wise Notified TB cases in Shrawan, 2081

Note: This monthly Bulletin is based on the information reported in DHIS2 through the Health Management Information System (HMIS) from health facilities including a comparison of the last twelve months. The data was archived on 17 Bhadra 2081.

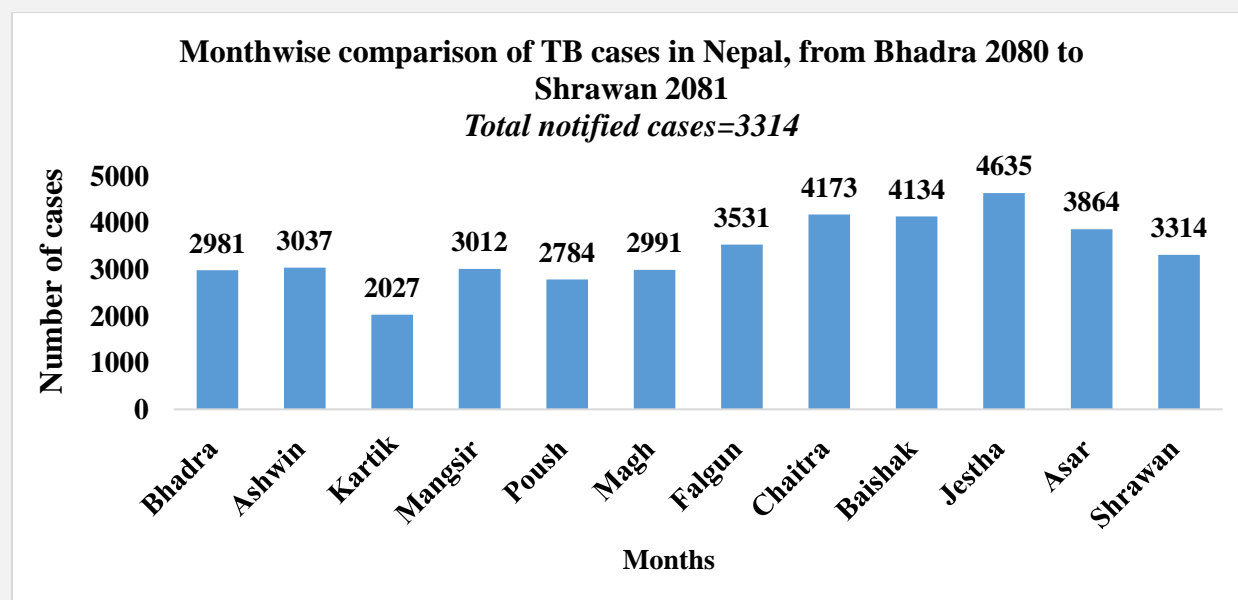


Figure 2: Month wise distribution of registered TB cases

The figure 2 above showed that the highest TB cases were reported in Jestha, 2081 and the least were in Kartik, 2080. Total 3314 TB cases were notified in Shrawan Month of Fiscal Year 2080/81 in Nepal.

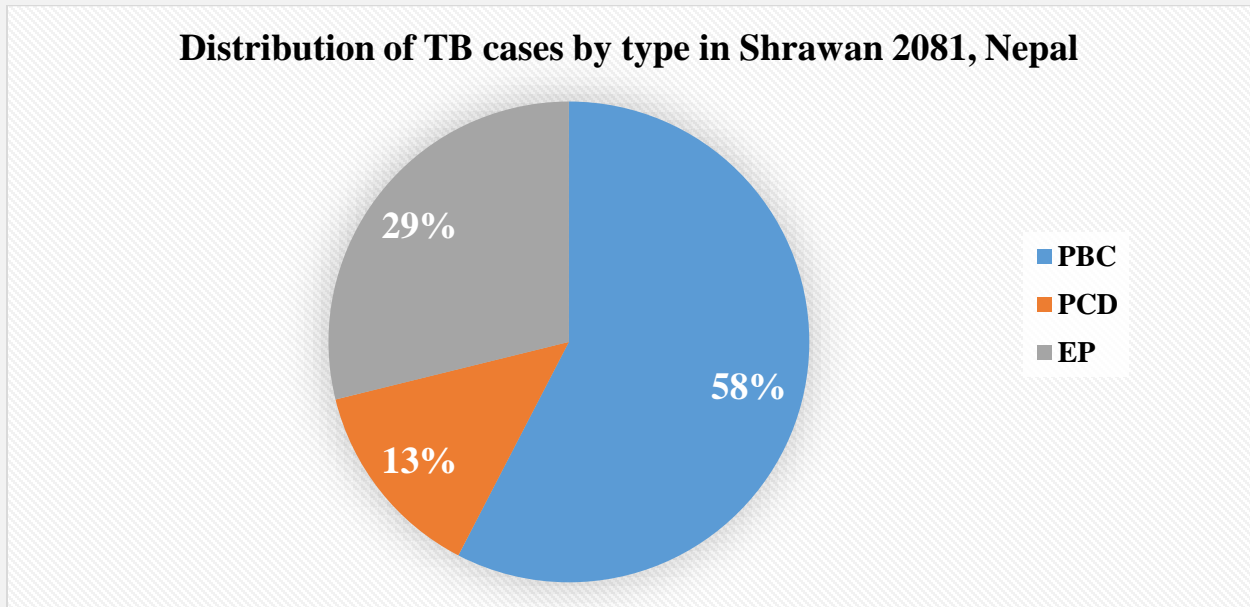


Figure 3: Distribution of TB cases by type of TB (n=3314)

Among the total notified cases in Shrawan, 58.0% were Pulmonary Bacteriologically Confirmed (PBC) cases, 13.0% were Pulmonary Clinically Diagnosed (PCD) and 29.0 % were Extra-Pulmonary (EP) TB (Figure 3).

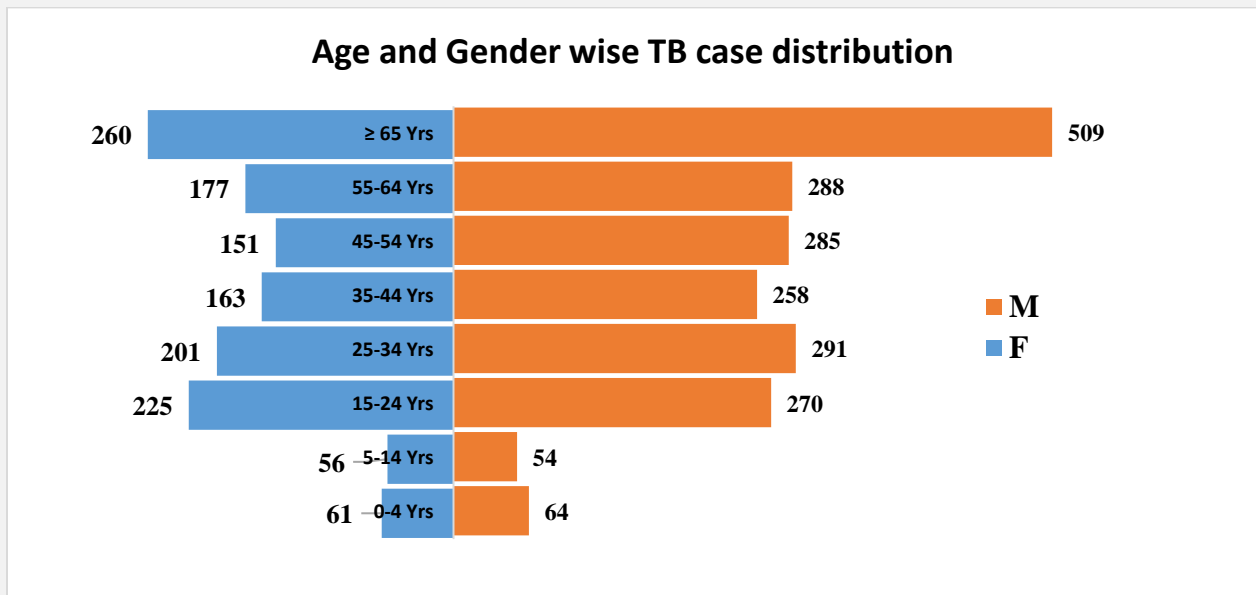


Figure 4: Age and gender-wise notified TB cases

Out of total, two thirds were male (61.0%) compared to female (39.0%). Regarding the age group, the majority were from 65+ years with 769 (23.0%) and the least were from the 5-14 years age group with 110 cases (3.3%).

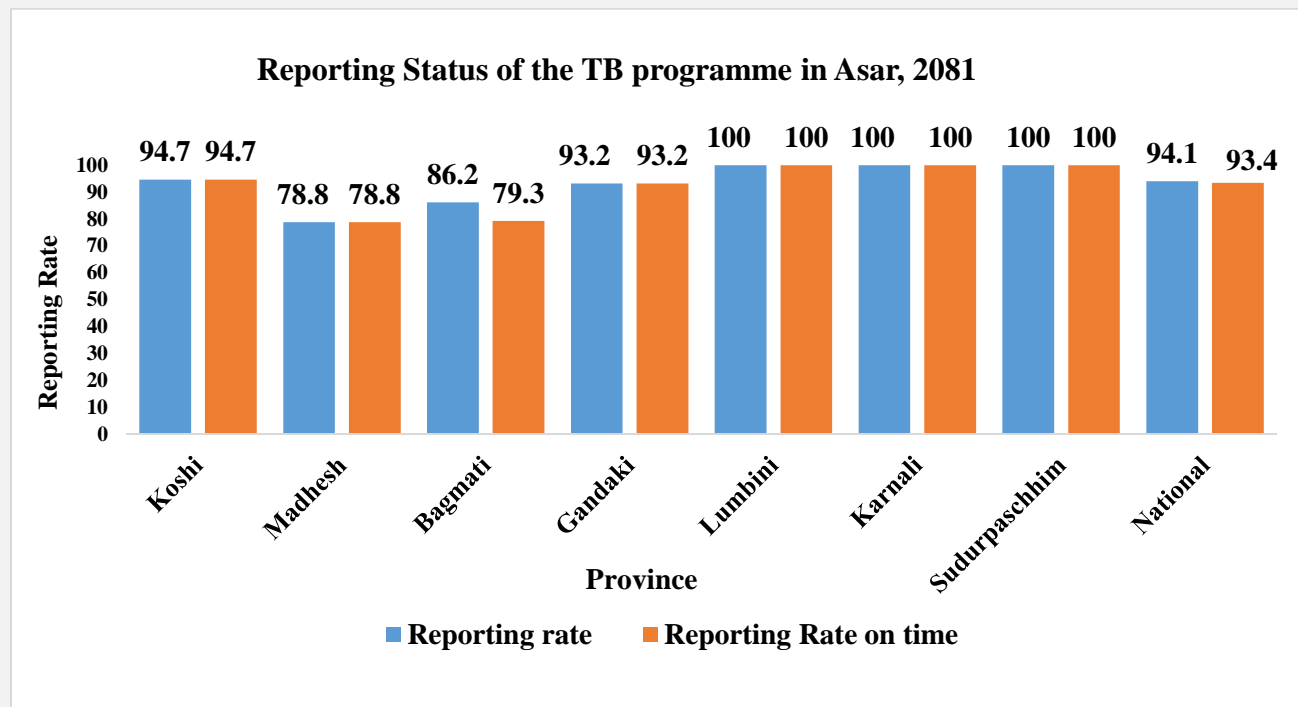


Figure 5: Reporting status of the TB programme

Lumbini, Karnali and Sudurpaschim Province had complete reporting status on time while Madhesh Province had only 78.8% regarding both completeness and timeliness. The nationwide reporting status in Shrawan 2081 in terms of completeness and timeliness was 94.1% and 93.4% respectively (Figure 5).

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
